FOCUS AREA	ACTION
Physical Environment	Disabled parking space available.
Physical Environment	Main entrance to school and internal doors accessible for wheel chairs.
Physical Environment	Disabled toilets for adults and children available.
Curriculum Access	All children to have access to the curriculum including out of school visits where appropriate. Individual needs risk assessed.
Curriculum Access	Classroom support and differentiation. Reasonable adjustments will be made to ensure all children achieve, for example, scribing, use of technology, coloured overlays etc.
Physical Disability	Any pupil with a physical disability will have access to the curriculum. A health care plan will be followed where appropriate and advice sought from outside agencies where necessary.
Physical Disability	Where necessary the school will seek advice from external agencies and provide visual and auxiliary aids where appropriate and adapt the environment to meet these recommendations.
Dietary	All children will have access to food provided by Cheshire East catering. For pupils who have specific dietary requirements, parental and medical advice will be sought.
