### HOMWORK TASKS WORTH 3 DOJO POINTS



Draw and label a *hoplite*.

What kind of armour would he have worn and why?

How is that different to a modern soldier?



### HOMWORK TASKS WORTH 5 DOJO POINTS



Create a comic strip of your favourite Greek myth: we've already learnt about Hercules, Icarus, Orpheus and Theseus.

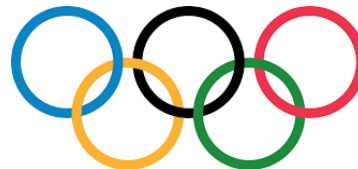


Make a list of 10 words that we use today that are based on Greek words - along with their meaning.



*For example - democracy comes from **demos** (people) and **kratos** (power).*

Make a poster advertising the Ancient Greek Olympics. What sports would you have been able to see?



Write a diary entry from the viewpoint of an Ancient Greek.

It could be as a slave, a Spartan soldier or an Athenian teacher. Write about the things you would have done in a day and how you might feel about it.
