Go on Times Tables Rockstars to practise.</p>	<p><b>Geography - Countries of the United Kingdom</b> Find out about the four countries that make up the United Kingdom. Can you find out the capital city of each country and some interesting facts?</p>
<p><b>English Activity 2 - Proper and common nouns</b> Choose some different nouns (remember nouns are people, places or objects). Can you sort them into proper and common nouns? Remember proper nouns are names such as Crewe and Asda.</p>	<p><b>Maths Activity 2 - Writing numbers as word</b> Choose ten two digit numbers (e.g. 56, 38) and write them as a word. Make sure you spell them correctly.</p>	<p><b>Reading - Author Study</b> Choose your favourite author and research and find out some facts about them.
