The tiny boat **danced** wildly in the waves.
The moon **played** hide and seek with the clouds.

(The verb is the human-like action the object is doing).

Can you write your own examples of personification using the following objects or animals described:

- Trees
- Car
- Alarm clock
- Lightning

Maths Activity Two

Last week, the lessons on The Oaks National Academy were based on converting units of measure. To recap that learning, your task is to create a knowledge organiser for converting units of measure.

Your knowledge organiser (poster with key information on) should include the following:

- Key vocabulary (e.g. kilograms, mass etc.)
- Examples of key conversions for length, weight, capacity and time (e.g. 10mm = 1 cm)
- Reference to metric and imperial measures

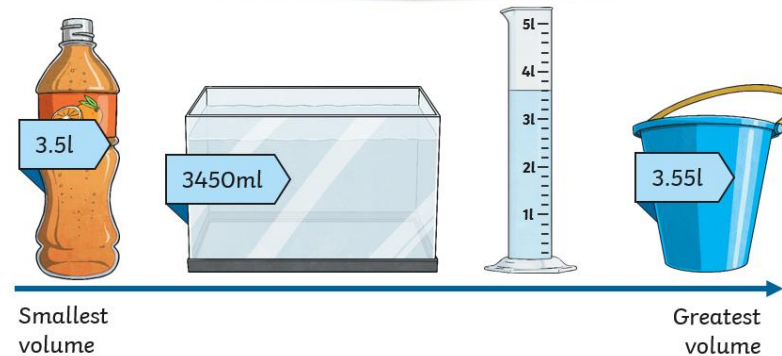

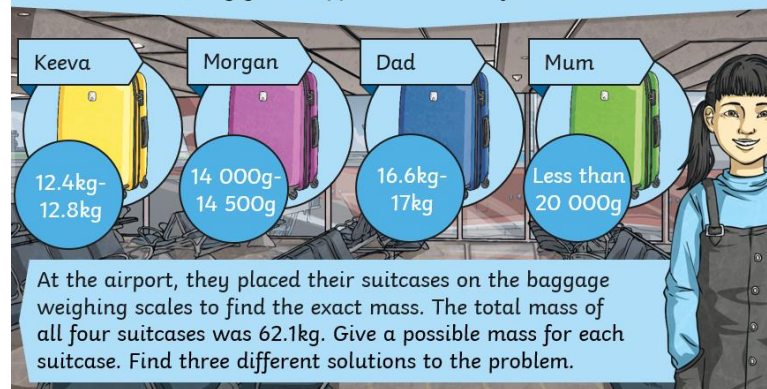
Converting Units of Measure- Problems

English Activity Four

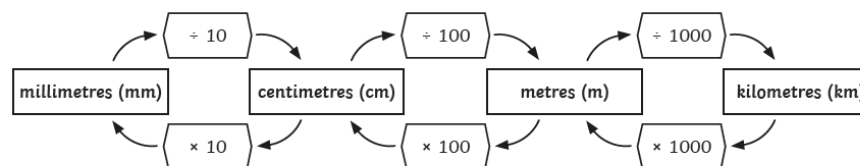
Write out the sentences again, making sure you have corrected any spelling mistakes!
