Talk about the different steps as you do it.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths Activity 1</b></p> <p>Choose three numbers within 10 and add them together. Repeat x 10. Show your working out with counters if you need to.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>History</b></p> <p>Find out what a family tree is. Can you make one for your family?</p>

Verbally give instructions for someone else to follow.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths Activity 2</b></p> <p>Use tens and ones to solve: 41 + 6, 23 + 2, 60 + 4, 82 + 5, 46 + 1, 13 + 3, 70 + 3, 65 + 1</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reading Challenge</b></p> <p>Can you video call a family member and share a story together? They could read to you, or you could read to them.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>English Activity 3</b></p> <p>Talk about time words with an adult. <i>First, next, then, after that, finally</i> Can you tie your shoelaces and give verbal instructions using these words?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths Activity 3</b></p> <p>Use tens and ones to solve: 39-7, 64-2, 78-4, 29-8, 32-2, 68-4, 59-1, 85-5</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science</b></p> <p>Get a big piece of paper (a strip of spare wallpaper would be great). Get an adult to draw around your body. Add labels to as many body parts as you can.</p>

Remember to add in time words to start your sentences.</p> <p><b>Adults:</b> If this week you only manage learning to tie shoelaces and not the writing activities, please don't worry. Find out and learn your own address. Can you name the street, town, and county?</p>
