English

English Activity 1 - Story Writing

Have a think about the RESPECT character animals used in KS1 at school. Resilience lion, Enterprise hippo, Self Confidence giraffe, Pride zebra, Experiences elephant, Communication chimp, Teamwork tiger. Choose one of these characters and write a story about how they gained that name. They will need to demonstrate the RESPECT characteristic in the story.

English Activity 2 - Common Exception Words

Choose five of the common exception words that you find most tricky to remember how to spell. Can you create a poster or think of a rhyme to help you remember it? For example, 'because' can be remembered by 'big elephants can always understand small elephants. These are called mnemonics.

English Activity 3 - Letter writing

Can you write a letter to your new teacher in Year Four? Tell them a little bit about yourself and what you like doing. You could include information about your family and favourite subjects in school. Ask them some questions too so you can find out more information about them!

Maths Activity 1 - Time

Bella starts walking to her friend's house at 2.45pm. She estimates that it will take her 37 minutes to get there. She tells her friend that she will be there at 3.15pm. Is she correct? Explain your answer.

Maths Activity 2 - Place Value

Ruby thinks of a number. Can you work out the number using the clues?
The number has three digits.
Only two of the digits have a value and they are not adjacent.
The total of all the digits is nine.
The hundreds digit is 7 more than the tens digit.
Can you make up your own mystery number challenge for a family member or myself?

Some children researched how a class of children travelled to school. Use the data in this table to create a scale bar chart or pictogram. Have a go at using a scale of 2!
